- You should read over your final draft and make neat changes in your test booklet.

- have an introduction, body, and a conclusion?
- stay on topic?
- have interesting and clear ideas?
- have correct punctuation and capital letters?

REMEMBER:

- ◆ Do not write a poem or a song. If you do, it will not be scored.
- ◆ Make your response long enough for others to understand your ideas.
- ◆ Read your final draft and make any changes neatly.
- ◆ **Use only the pages in your test booklet to write your final draft.**
